The following pages attempt to record the people, events and school spirit, each of which were essential in making this, the fiftieth year of our college, one of the most important in its history.

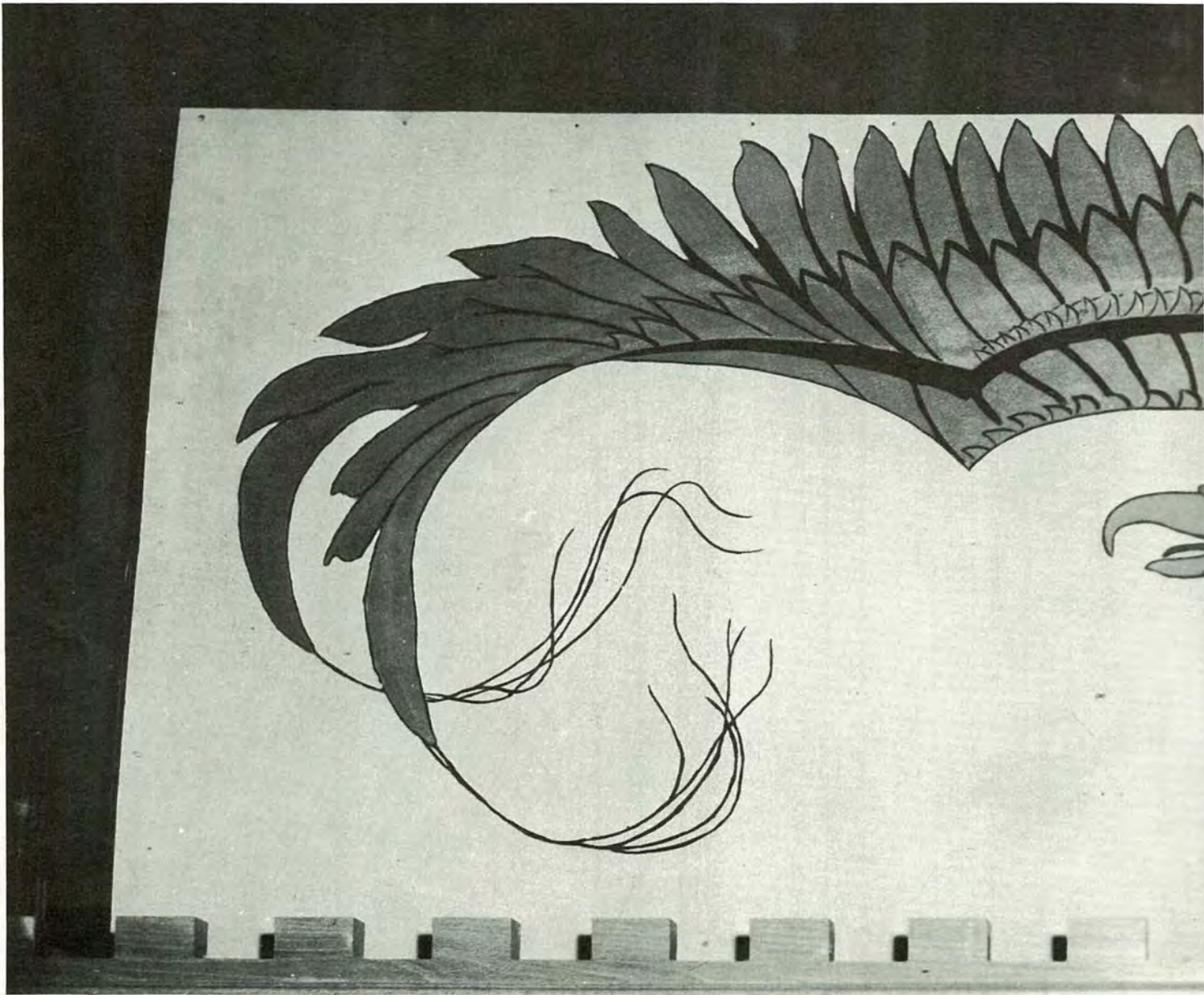
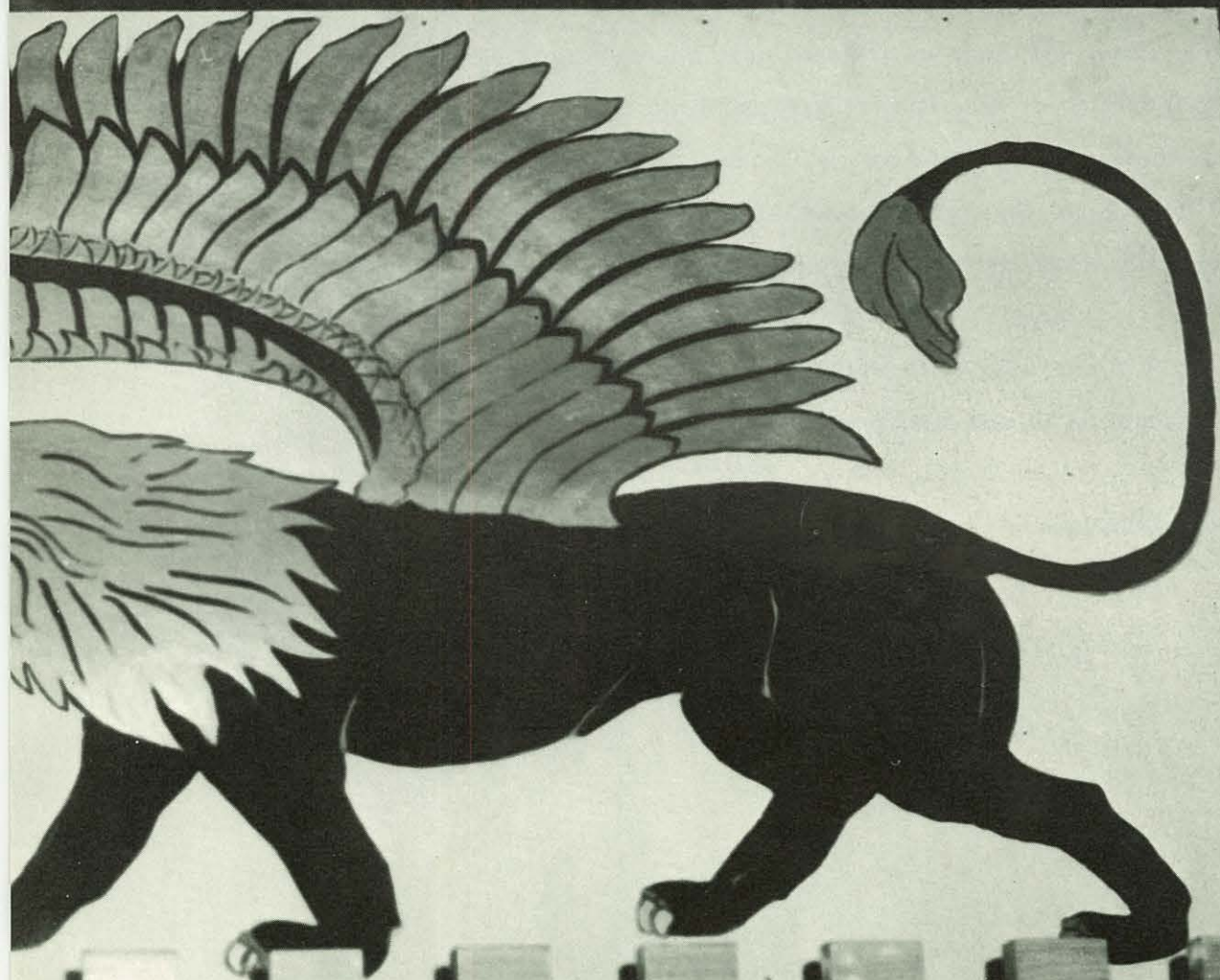
