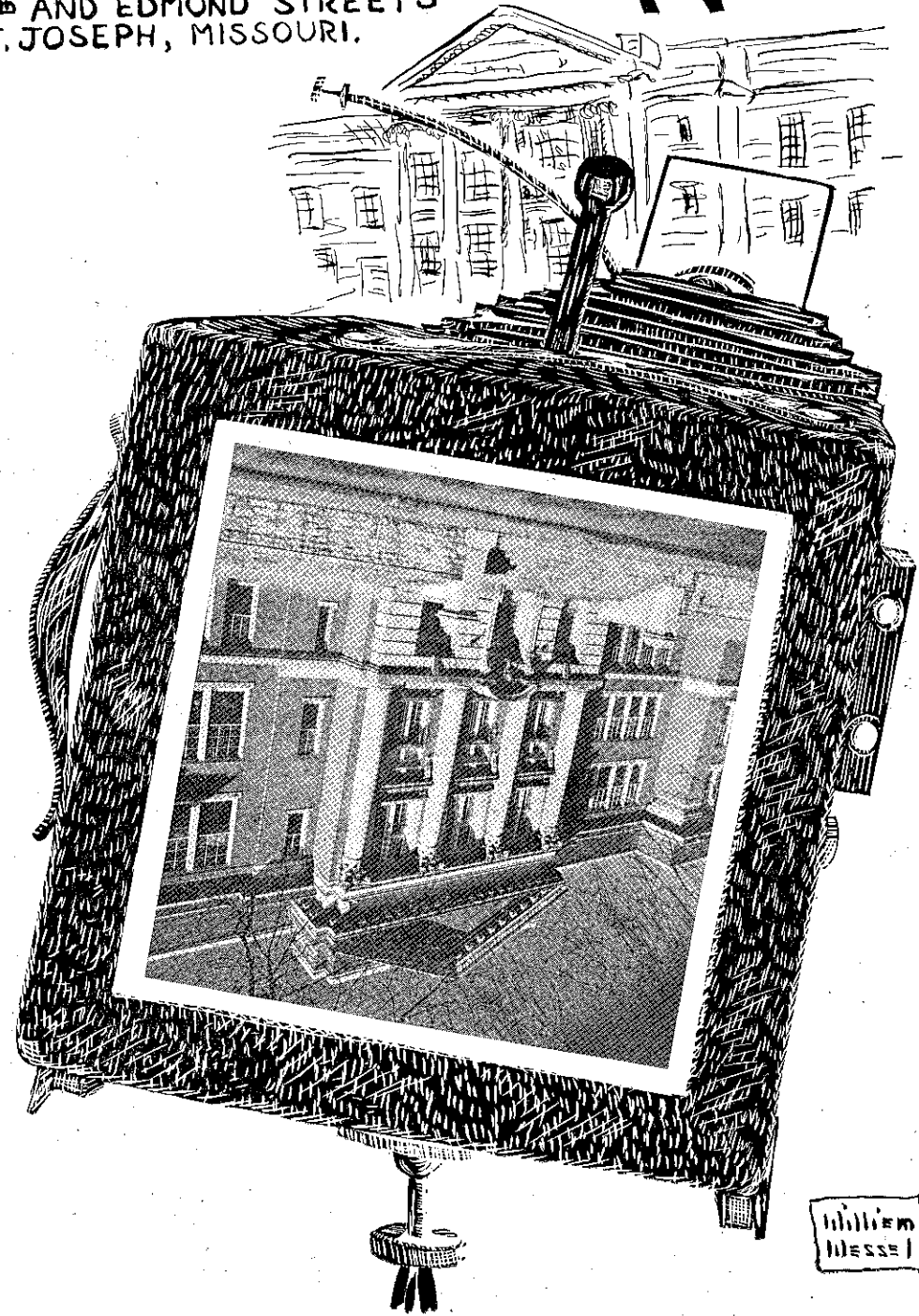

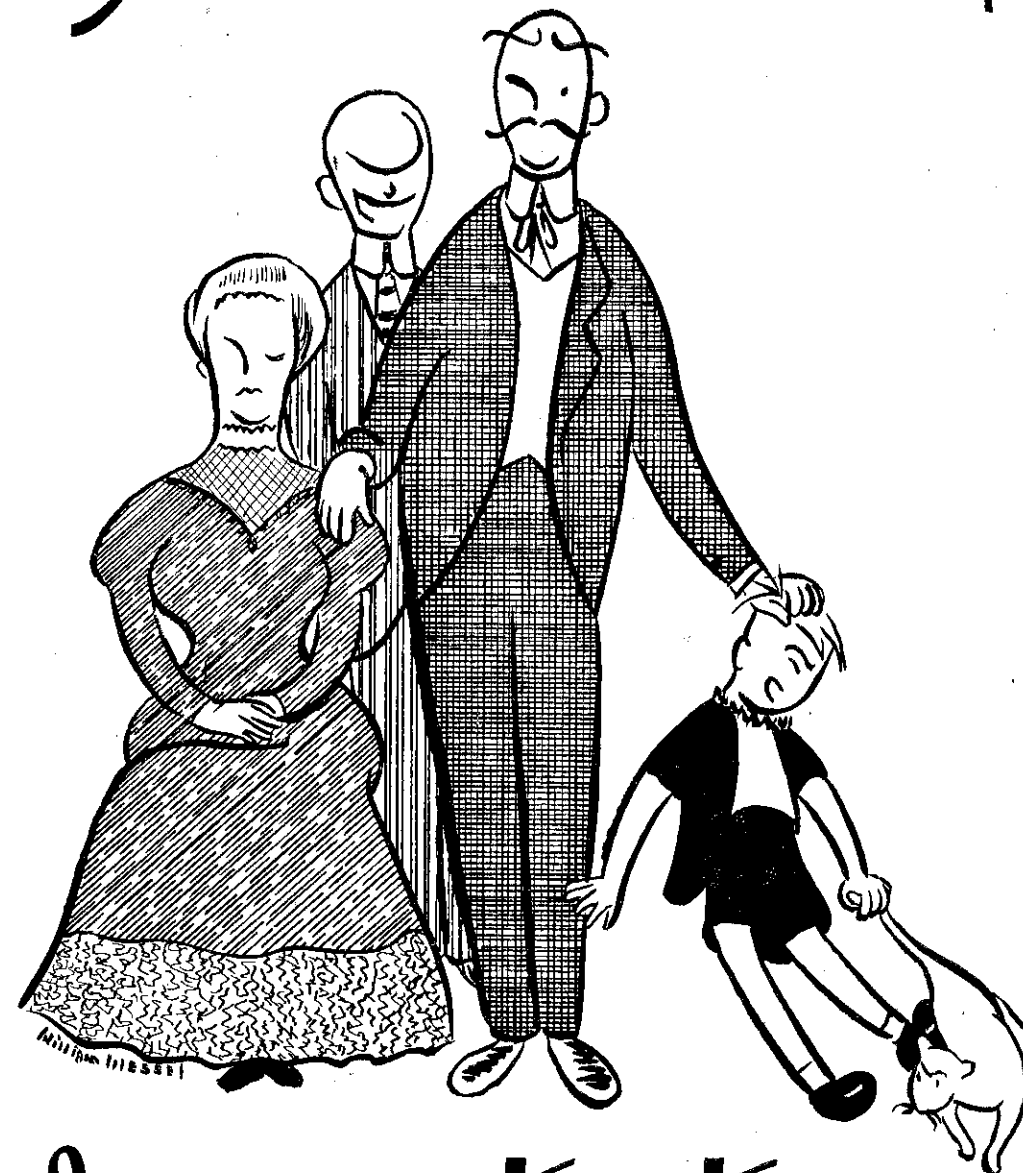
FOREWORD
